## 2011 Bridge Nominations

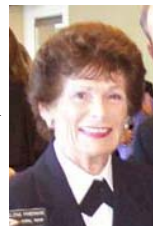
### SECRETARY: Lt/C EVELYN B. NORTHRUP, AP
