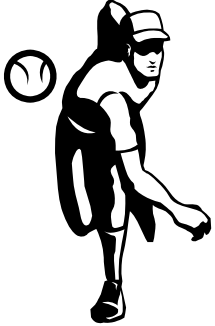

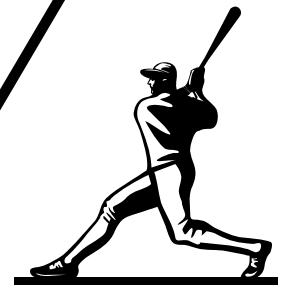

- A motion was made and approved to refund cost of Boat Smart Class if the student becomes a Squadron Member at completion of course.

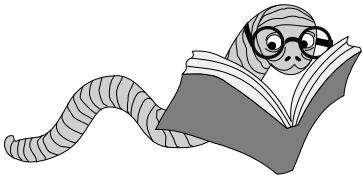
