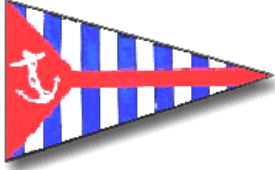

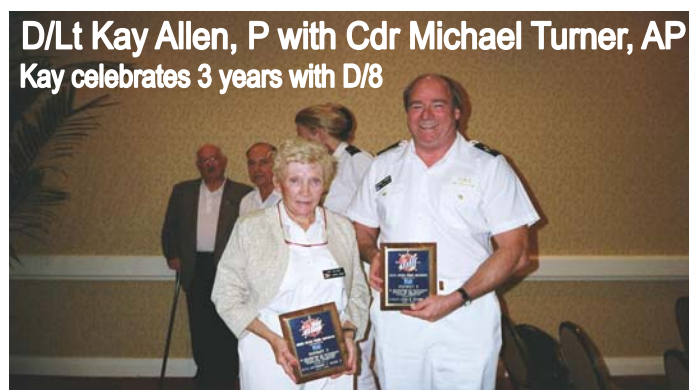

LIFE JACKETS IN THE BOX HAVE NO VALUE IN SAVING LIVES

There's something new for Vessel Safety Examiners, Public Boating Course instructors, and Boat Show volunteers. The US Coast Guard, as a key component of their Recreational Boating Safety Program, has instituted a campaign to encourage boaters to wear their PFD's, and to demonstrate how easily an inflatable PFD can be worn at all times on the water. After all, a PFD isn't much use if it isn't being worn. The US Power Squadrons are committed to support and implement this program, nationwide.

Although the actual date for roll-out of this program is yet to be determined, it will likely be soon. Inflatable life jackets emblazoned with the "Wear It" logo will be made available on loan to each VSC chair and SEO for sharing within each squadron. The recipients must wear the inflatable life jacket at all times during vessel safety checks, teaching the public, public appearances, manning a display booth, or walking the dock to solicit VSC customers. We'll let you know when this important program becomes effective.
