2007 Awards Dinner

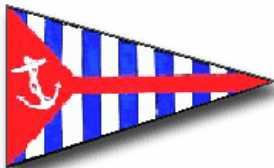

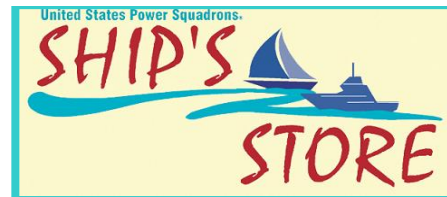

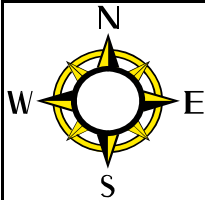
